**A.** All information in this section is required for us to process your form.

**C.** If you elect the ORP, and are a current PERS member, you will be placed into the tier based on your individual situation.

If you elect the ORP, contributions will be sent to the fund sponsor you select. To avoid delays, set up your online investment account as soon as possible.

If you are already a PERS member and wish to remain in PERS, you will be placed into the tier based on your individual situation.
